Special-Lite's new Testing Summary brochure highlights the important performance tests their doors have passed, including their most popular, high-performance Fiberglass Reinforced Polyester (FRP) SL-17 Flush Door. The tests reviewed cover both industry standard tests conducted by third party laboratories and proprietary tests designed to evaluate real world performance.

An impact test evaluates how their FRP Flush Doors' lightweight and flexible design helps them stand up to high impact forces even when the door is blocked open. An exposure test confirms their products' fade-resistance and ability to withstand thermal extremes.

The brochure concludes that the best measure of door performance is how they stand the test of time in actual installations. It cites a number of demanding, high-traffic and/or environmentally challenging applications where Special-Lite doors are proving their durability.
