Special-Lite, Inc. has introduced a new fire-rated door with its exclusive “sandstone texture” fiberglass reinforced polyester (FRP) face sheet. The Special-Lite® SL-23 Sandstone-Textured FRP-Clad Fire-Rated Door features a fine-grained face sheet with a more subtle surface finish and less glossy appearance than standard FRP surfaces. Tested in accordance with UBC 7-2, NFPA 252 and UL 10C requirements, the SL-23 has passed the 1-hour positive pressure test, hose stream test, and 250 degree temperature rise tests to achieve Warnock Hersey listing for fire-rating applications in the U.S.

The SL-23 is available in 30, 45 or 60-minute rated versions for interior or exterior use, as singles or pairs up to 4' x 8' per leaf. It features the same aesthetically-pleasing face sheets as the Special-Lite SL-20 Sandstone-Textured FRP Flush Door, bonded to a mineral core with a perimeter designed for secure hardware attachment. Edge capping and

vision lite kits are natural stainless steel, similar in appearance to clear anodized aluminum. Edge capping is screw applied, welded and buffed at corners. The SL-23 door requires the use of fire-rated hardware, framing and vision lites.
